Anniversary Dance Yes ____ No ____

This is great way to get all your guests onto the dance floor. Here's how it works... Couples are called onto the dance floor based on years of marriage and working down from 50+ years until all married couples are dancing. (Song selection starting with an oldie and working up as needed)

Avalanche Dance Yes ____ No ____

This is another great way to get all your guests onto the dance floor. Here's how it works... The wedding party is called onto the dance floor and a song is played (The song is a fast song) and the wedding party begins dancing. Now, when they hear the music stop, each person will go into the audience and bring back a different dance partner to the dance floor. Then, when everyone comes back to the dance floor, the dancing begins again. This cycle continues until everyone is on the dance floor. This dance is usually done at the beginning of the open dancing.
